 2A ʔananakhak ṭaatṇeʔis. How many children do you have?
 2B čawaanakah ṭaṇeʔis..... I have one child.
 2B ʔayanakah..... I have lots.
 2B wikiituk^waḥ..... I don't have any.
 3A ʔačaqa yaa. Who's that?
 3B ʔuq̣ḥỵuumah yaa. That's my relative.
 3B ʔuuksčaṭinmah yaa..... That's my friend.
 3B ʔuk^winkah yaa. I'm with him, her. That's my partner.
 3B ʔučiimah yaa. I'm married to him, her.
