 1B Cecil ʔuḥuk^wintsiš ṇuṇwiiqsu. My late father was Cecil.
 2A čaa quṇaaṇakik ṭaatṇaʔis. How many children do you have?
 2B čawaanaksiš ṭaṇaʔis..... I have one child.
 2B ʔayanaksiš..... I have lots.
 2B wikiituksiš. I don't have any.
 3A ʔačaaqḥ ḥaa. Who's that?
 3B ʔuqḥyuuysiš ḥaa. That's my relative.
 3B ʔuuksčaṇinsiš ḥaa. That's my friend.
 3B ʔuk^winksiš ḥaa. I'm with him, her. That's my partner.
 3B ʔučisiš ḥaa. I'm married to him, her.
