- 2A ?anaḥa taatne?is. How many children are there?
- 2B sučama taatne?is. There are five children.
- 2B ?ayama taatne?is. There are many children.
- 2B wikiitma taatne?is. There aren't any children.
- 2B hayaa?akah qumaayii taatne?is. I don't know how many children there are.
- 3A ?aqaǎaḥa ḥaas. What day is it?
- 3A ?anačii?ǎaḥa. What day is it?
- 3B ḥupčii?ǎama. It's Monday.
- 3B hayaa?akah q^wiǎai ḥaas. I don't know what day it is.

- 4A ?anaq?ičḥ?ǎaḥak. How old are you?
