## **?utwii • Introduction**

We will learn some things to say when we're eating together. For example, 'What do you need?' 'Pass the butter.'

# huuḥtakšiƛaya • Beginning

Practise calling people to the table.

1A. čamaasiipi. .... Set the table.

1A. čamaasiipič. .... Set the table, you all.

1A. čamaas?aƛuk?ick ha?um. .. Your food is on the table.

1A. čamaas?aƛuk?icuuš ha?um.    Your all's food is on the table.

Practise thanking the one who fed you.
