- 1A huksaawitasniș. huksčiʔałi! We're going to count. Start counting!
- 1B ćawaak, ʔała, qacća, muu, suća..... One, two, three, four, five.
- 2A quńaayii ťaatńaʔis..... How many children are there?
- 2B sućaʔiș ťaatńaʔis. There are five children.
- 2B ʔayaʔiș ťaatńaʔis..... There are many children.
- 2B wikiitʔiș ťaatńaʔis..... There aren't any children.
- 3A ʔaqaɣałħ ńaaș. What day is it?
- 3A quńaačiiʔałii..... What day is it?
- 3B ńupčiiʔałiș. It's Monday.
- 3B hayumħiș q^wiɣałii ńaaș.* I don't know what day it is.
- 4A quńaaqʔiçħʔałiik. How old are you?
- 4B ʔałak^wałqʔiçħʔałsiș. I'm eight years old.
- 4B ħayu ʔuħʔiış ńupuqʔiçħʔałsiș. I'm sixteen years old.

- 5A qumaaqumłnakiik taana.*How many dollars do you have?
- 5B ʔaʔqumłnaksiš taana.*I have two dollars.
