- 1A huksaaḥitasniš. huksčiʔałi! ..... We're going to count. Start counting!
- 1B ćawaak, ʔała, qacća, muu, suća..... One, two, three, four, five.
- 2A čaa quḥaayi ṭaatḥaʔis. .... How many children are there?
- 2B sućaʔiš ṭaatḥaʔis. .... There are five children.
- 2B ʔayaʔiš ṭaatḥaʔis. .... There are many children.
- 2B wikiitʔiš ṭaatḥaʔis. .... There aren't any children.
- 3A ʔaqaḥałḥ ḥaas. .... What day is it?
- 3A čaa quḥaačiłʔałi..... What day is it?
- 3B ḥupćiiłʔał.ʔiš. .... It's Monday.
- 3B hayumḥisiš q<sup>w</sup>iḥałi ḥaas.\* ..... I don't know what day it is.
- 4A čaa quḥaaqʔičḥʔałik. .... How old are you?
- 4B ʔałak<sup>w</sup>ałqʔičḥʔałsiš. .... I'm eight years old.
- 4B ḥayu ʔuḥʔiš ḥupuqʔičḥʔałsiš. .... I'm sixteen years old.

- 5A čaa quṁaaquṁṁnakik taana.\* .....How many dollars do you have?
- 5B ṁaḷquṁṁnaksiš taana.\* .....I have two dollars.
- 5B ṁayaaksiš taana.....I have lots of money.
- 5B wikiituksiš taana.....I don't have any money.
