 1B Lucy ʔuḥuksiš ʔumʔiiqsu. My mother is Lucy.
 1B Cecil ʔuḥuk^witsiš ḥuʔwiiqsu. My late father was Cecil.
- 2A quḥaanakiik ʔaḥaḥaʔis..... How many children do you have?
 2B čawaanaksiš ʔaḥaʔis..... I have one child.
 2B ʔayanaksiš..... I have lots.
 2B wikiituksiš. I don't have any.
- 3A ʔačaqḥ ḥaa..... Who's that?
 3B ʔuq̣ḥỵuusiš ḥaa. That's my relative.
 3B ʔuuksčaʔinsiš ḥaa. That's my friend.
 3B ʔuk^winksiš ḥaa. I'm with him, her. That's my partner.
 3B ʔučisiš ḥaa. I'm married to him, her.
