 2A quṁaakiik ṭaatnaʔs..... How many children do you have?
 2B čawaanks ṭaṭnaʔs.* I have one child.
 2B ʔayaanks.* I have lots.
 2B wikiitk^ws. I don't have any.
 3A ʔačaaqḥ ḥaaʔaḥ. Who's that?
 3B ʔuq̣ḥỵuus ḥaaʔaḥ. That's my relative.
 3B ʔuupaał^ws ḥaaʔaḥ.* That's my friend.
 3B ʔuk^winks ḥaaʔaḥ. I'm with him, her. That's my partner.
 3B ʔuḥas ḥaaʔaḥ. I'm married to him, her.
